WHO WE ARE Our Mission



Our mission is to help people living in extreme poverty achieve major improvements in their lives that last and spread without ongoing support from Concern.

Our role is to ensure that people living in extreme poverty are able to meet their basic needs, achieve their rights and manage their own development. We do so by working with communities and by using our shared experience and knowledge to address the root causes of extreme poverty. To achieve this mission, we engage in long-term development work and respond to emergency situations.

Our Vision

Concern's work is informed by a vision for change. We envision a world in which no one lives in poverty, fear, or oppression; in which all have access to a decent standard of living and the opportunities and choices essential to a long, healthy, and creative life; and in which everyone is treated with dignity and respect.

- The fundamental belief that all people are entitled to equal rights, regardless of circumstance.
- A commitment to rapid and effective emergency response in strict adherence to humanitarian principles.
- The operational imperative that all of our work starts with listening to people, ultimately partnering with communities to transform lives and livelihoods.
- The relentless pursuit of solutions that are innovative as well as pragmatic, in response to specific community needs.
- Complete accountability and transparency in all of our actions and use of resources.

OUR AREAS OF FOCUS



Emergencies & Refugees

Emergency response is a core pillar of Concern's work. Whether it's conflict, a natural disaster, or a refugee crisis, Concern responds rapidly while ensuring that local priorities guide our actions, and we stay long after the headlines fade to help communities rebuild.

Health & Nutrition

Concern has led the way in standard-setting programs that strengthen local health systems and provide quality nutrition support to the world's most vulnerable communities. And because hunger doesn't happen in isolation, we integrate our health and nutrition programs into all other programming.

Livelihoods

To break the cycle of poverty, we identify and address the underlying issues faced by people living in extreme poverty. Our livelihoods programs help people manage their natural resources and gain the skills and knowledge they need to work.

Climate & Environment

Climate shocks are becoming more intense and more frequent each year, and too often, those who bear the least responsibility for climate change suffer its effects the most. We promote eco-friendly programming tailored to local environments and designed to help communities sustainably manage food, water, and other natural resources.

Education

All children have a right to a quality education. With education being key to breaking the cycle of extreme poverty, we strive to create safe learning environments for children and support the creation of quality teaching and learning.

Gender Equality

Gender inequality is a major barrier to ending poverty. Every program that Concern implements is designed to be gender transformative to address and combat harmful gender dynamics in the communities with which we partner.

FUNDRAISING IDEAS

Bake Sale

Who doesn't love a sweet treat? With your team, bake some of your favorite baked goods, pick a date and location – outside of your school, in your town, or at an event – and start selling!

Garage Sale

This is a great way to clean out your house and raise money for Concern! Organize a garage sale and get your friends and family in on it too - they can donate items to sell and help increase your impact.

Bottle Collection

If you live in a state that has a redemption value on bottles and cans, set a collection day with your team, friends, family, and community and spread the word that your collections will go to a great cause!

Social Media

Reach out to friends and family via social media! Whether you set up a fun challenge for people to join along, or simply create a series of fundraising posts, social media is a simple way to get involved.

Facebook Live Fundraiser

Consider inviting experts or professors on a topic related to Concern's mission to give a talk and lead a Q&A on Facebook Live. Or, provide entertainment by asking a local band to perform.

Celebrate with Concern

Celebrate a special occasion with this simple and personal way to make a difference. Ask friends and family to donate on your behalf for your birthday, wedding, or other special day.

Raffle

Set up a raffle with each ticket sale going towards your fundraiser! You can connect with local businesses to donate prizes for the raffle. The raffle can take place at an event or party, or on your social media.

Contact Local Businesses

Local businesses are great resources for fundraising. Reach out and ask if they're interested in donating, ask to set up a donation tin in their store, or ask if they can donate a raffle prize!

GETTING STARTED



1. Define Your Goals

Identify the programs or project you want to support; then, determine the target amount to fundraise and the specific objectives to achieve.

2. Choose a Fundraiser Idea

Select a fundraiser idea from the suggestions provided or create your own.

3. Build a Team

Recruit volunteers by forming a group of dedicated friends, coworkers, students, faculty members, or family that will help you with your fundraiser.

4. Start a Fundraiser Page

Visit **<u>concernusa.org/getstarted</u>** and click Start a Fundraiser. You can customize your page and share your story (why does Concern's work matter to you?).

5. Lead by Example

To jump-start your fundraiser, we recommend making a gift of any amount first to inspire others to follow suit.

6. Spread The Word

Gain the support of your friends, family, and colleagues by sharing your fundraiser in person – including hosting the event, if needed – or online.

7. Collect and Send Your Donations

Collect any cash or in-person donations and add them to your fundraising page.

8. Send Thank You Notes to Donors

Make sure to thank each donor for their contribution. Reach out in person or via email; if your fundraiser is on social media, thanking them publicly may inspire others to donate as well!
